

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION NOTICE

Application for an Approval Under the Provisions of the *Environmental Management Act*

We, LNG Canada Development Inc., 400 4th Avenue SW Calgary, AB, T2P 0J4, intend to submit this Approval application to the Director to authorize the discharge of treated effluent from the LNG Canada Liquid Natural Gas Export Facility.

The land upon which the Facility is situated and will discharge to occurs within District Lots 73, 93, 94, 96, 186, 187, 981, 5469, 6001, 6002, 6003, 6004, 6050 and 7940 located near Kitimat, British Columbia within the traditional territory of the Haisla Nation.

Contamination has been identified in groundwater in areas within the Facility footprint. Further, due to the industrial history of the area, there is potential that additional currently unknown contamination may be encountered. Suspected contaminated groundwater, identified through field observation and/or historical documentation, requiring dewatering, will be treated and discharged. The discharge criteria the permit would meet is the lowest applicable guideline, unless background is elevated for the given parameter, at which point the treatment target is the background concentration (within 20% of ambient) or except for where an appropriate alternative discharge limit for a specific contaminant is identified in the application.

Any person who may be adversely affected by the proposed Approval and wishes to provide relevant information may, within 30 days after the last date of posting, publishing, service or display, send written comments to the applicant, with a copy to Devin Scheck, Supervisor, Environmental Stewardship, BC Oil and Gas Commission, at Bag 2, Fort St. John, B.C. V1J 2B0. The identity of any respondents and the contents of anything submitted in relation to this application will become part of the public record.
