

## ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION NOTICE

Application for a Permit Amendment Under the Provisions of the *Environmental Management Act*.


We, LNG Canada Development Inc., 400 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW Calgary, AB, T2P 0J4, intend to submit this permit amendment application to the Director to authorize the discharge of treated effluent from the LNG Canada Liquefied Natural Gas Export Facility.

The land upon which the Facility is situated and will discharge to occurs within District Lots 6050, 6053, 6054, 6057, and 6267 located in Kitimat, British Columbia within the traditional territory of the Haisla Nation.

Potential contaminants have been identified in groundwater along the right-of-way for the raw water intake pipeline. Further, due to the industrial history of the area, there is potential that additional currently unknown contamination may be encountered. Suspected contaminated groundwater, identified through field observation and/or historical documentation, requiring dewatering, will be treated and discharged. The discharge criteria for the permit would meet the applicable guidelines, unless background is elevated for the given parameter, in which case the treatment target is the background concentration (within 20% of ambient).

Any person who may be adversely affected by the proposed Approval of waste and wishes to provide relevant information may, within 30 days after the last date of posting, publishing, service or display, send written comments to the applicant, with a copy to Devin Scheck, Supervisor, Environmental Stewardship, BC Oil and Gas Commission, at Bag 2, Fort St. John, B.C. V1J 2B0. The identity of any respondents and contents of anything submitted in relation to this application will become part of the public record.
